15. WESTERN BUS SERVICE REVIEW – WATERLOO WORKER SERVICE, BRAEBURN DRIVE

The Board was in receipt of a report by the City Streets Manager seeking approval for a new bus stop in Braeburn Drive, being part of the new Waterloo worker bus service. The report had been received by the Board's Works and Traffic Committee, at its 20 April 2001 meeting.

The Board **resolved** to approve the installation of a bus stop on the western side of Braeburn Drive, commencing at a point 14 metres from its intersection with Waterloo Road, and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
