

## 6. PARKS AND WATERWAYS CAPITAL PROGRAMME

The Board **received** a report on progress of Parks and Waterways capital projects within the Board area as at 1 April 2001. The Parks and Waterways Advocate advised that a concept plan was being developed for Heaphy Place. This will go to residents and then to the Board for approval. He also advised that the funds for Belfast cemetery were being reallocated as they cannot be spent this financial year. However the Parks and Waterways unit was still looking at purchasing land adjacent to the cemetery.

The Chairperson requested a progress report on the waterway enhancement at Papanui Domain, and a report to the Board on the oak tree problem in James Condon Park.
