10. SECURITY SPECIALISTS TO ASSIST IN CENTRAL CITY

The Director of Policy reported on a proposal presented to the Annual Plan Working Party by Inspector D M Lawry, Area Controller Hagley-Ferrymead of the New Zealand Police for the employment of security persons for the early hours of Saturday and Sunday in the central city.

The Committee decided:

- 1. That the proposal be deferred, pending receipt of the information from Wellington City and discussions with the Police, Safer Community Council and other relevant groups.
- 2. That the District Commander of Police, Superintendent John Reilly, be invited to address a seminar meeting of the Council on the issue of safety in the central city.
