

8. BAKER STREET: PARKING RESTRICTIONS

The Area Engineer (Community) sought the Board's approval for the installation of "No Stopping At Any Time" parking restrictions in Baker Street as part of the kerb and channel renewal work proposed for this street. The Board **resolved**:

1. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the western side of Baker Street commencing at its intersection with New Brighton Road and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 20 metres.
2. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the northern side of New Brighton Road commencing at its intersection with Baker Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 8 metres.
3. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the eastern side of Baker Street commencing at its intersection with New Brighton Road and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 15 metres.
4. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the northern side of New Brighton Road commencing at its intersection with Baker Street and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 10 metres.
5. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the western side of Baker Street commencing at a point 8 metres from 124 Baker Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 40 metres.
6. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the eastern side of Baker Street commencing at a point 5 metres from 121 Baker Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 35 metres.
7. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the eastern side of Baker Street commencing at its intersection with Gresham Terrace and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 13 metres.
8. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the southern side of Gresham Terrace commencing at its intersection with Baker Street and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 7 metres.
9. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the eastern side of Baker Street commencing at its intersection with Gresham Terrace and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 15 metres.
10. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the northern side of Gresham Terrace commencing at its intersection with Baker Street and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 7 metres.
11. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the eastern side of Baker Street commencing at its intersection with Dennitt Street and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 16 metres.
12. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the southern side of Dennitt Street commencing at its intersection with Baker Street and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 9 metres.
13. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the eastern side of Baker Street commencing at its intersection with Dennitt Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 15 metres.
14. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the northern side of Dennitt Street commencing at its intersection with Baker Street and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 9 metres.
15. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the western side of Baker Street commencing at its intersection with Bowhill Road and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 14 metres.
16. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the southern side of Bowhill Road commencing at its intersection with Baker Street and extending in a westerly direction for a distance of 9 metres.

17. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the eastern side of Baker Street commencing at its intersection with Bowhill Road and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 19 metres.
18. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the southern side of Bowhill Road commencing at its intersection with Baker Street and extending in a easterly direction for a distance of 9 metres.
