6. EUREKA STREET PARKING

A report from the Traffic Engineer (Community) sought to formally resolve the parking issues in Eureka Street when the road is formed into a cul-de-sac as part of the Woolston/Burwood Expressway project. The Board **resolved:**

- 1. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time on the east side of Eureka Street, commencing at its intersection with Meon Street and extending in a northerly direction up to, and around the cul-de-sac end.
- 2. The stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time along the west side of Eureka Street commencing at a point 11 metres south of its intersection with Meon Street and extending in a northerly direction for a distance of 30 metres.
- 3. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of 5 minutes between the hours of 8.00 am to 9.00 am, 2.30 pm to 3.30 pm, Mondays to Friday on the west side of Eureka Street commencing at a point 11 metres from its intersection with Meon Street and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 16 metres.
- 4. That the parking of the mobile library be provided for between 9.40 am and 10.20 am on Tuesdays on the west side of Eureka Street commencing at a point 11 metres from its intersection with Meon Street and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 16 metres.
- 5. That a "Give Way" sign be placed against Eureka Street at its intersection with Meon Street.
- 6. That the parking restrictions be reviewed after 12 months.
