18. PARKS, ENVIRONMENT AND LEISURE COMMITTEE

The Board considered a report of its Parks, Environment and Leisure Committee meeting held on 10 October 2002 and **resolved** to adopt the following recommendations:

1. Public Art

- (a) That an approach be made to Art & Industry with a view to requesting that Deborah McCormack be appointed as Project Manager for this proposal.
- (b) That Marlene Le Cren put together a brief for this project.
- (c) That the Project Manager and Marlene Le Cren work with the Board's Parks, Environment and Leisure Committee to form a working party to progress.
- 2. That the Board consider providing funding for the project management fee (as this cost cannot be met from the Urban Renewal capital budget), subject to cost.

3. Landsdowne Terrace Street Trees

- 1. That the following changes/additions be made to the feedback form:
 - After the words "Please indicate your preferred option by ticking the box" add the words "(refer additional information set out on page 2 of the letter)".
 - Option B the last sentence to read "Replanting with these trees will eventually create a tall (20m), closed canopy within 15-20 years".
 - Option C Add (d) Prunus Pink Perfection (flowering cherry) height 4m.
 - Option C Add height of each specimen
