6. TE KUPENGA O ARANUI TRUST

An update was provided on the whanau support and community engagement work of Te Kupenga o Aranui Trust's Family Worker. This 2002/03 year is the third of a three year funding agreement between Te Kupenga o Aranui Trust, the Community Board and the Community Advocacy Team. The Board **decided:**

- 1. That the information be received.
- 2. That staff continue to work with Te Kupenga o Aranui and local community groups in exploring alternative accommodation for the programme.
- 3. That staff continue to work with the Aranui Community Renewal in exploring the possibilities of the Wainoni Park Annex building being utilised as a youth centre facility.
- 4. That the Community Board continue to include Te Kupenga o Aranui Trust as a priority project, and consider a grant from the Board's annual Project and Discretionary allocations.
- 5. That Te Kupenga o Aranui Trust be invited to seek continued funding from the Social Initiatives Fund.
- 6. That the Board advocate for central government funding for the Trust's Family Worker.
