


## 6. TE KUPENGA O ARANUI TRUST



An update was provided on the whanau support and community engagement work of Te Kupenga o Aranui Trust's Family Worker. This 2002/03 year is the third of a three year funding agreement between Te Kupenga o Aranui Trust, the Community Board and the Community Advocacy Team. The Board **decided:**

1. That the information be received.
2. That staff continue to work with Te Kupenga o Aranui and local community groups in exploring alternative accommodation for the programme.
3. That staff continue to work with the Aranui Community Renewal in exploring the possibilities of the Wainoni Park Annex building being utilised as a youth centre facility.
4. That the Community Board continue to include Te Kupenga o Aranui Trust as a priority project, and consider a grant from the Board's annual Project and Discretionary allocations.
5. That Te Kupenga o Aranui Trust be invited to seek continued funding from the Social Initiatives Fund.
6. That the Board advocate for central government funding for the Trust's Family Worker.
