0800LEIZUR - Leisure in the Commodity Age

The twin themes for this year's annual conference are "Leisure in the Commodity Age" and "Recreation to Go". The conference will focus on the changing face of leisure and explore the growth of recreation as a commodity and the new framework for government support of recreation and leisure. The conference will take place in Hamilton from 10 to 13 November.

Keynote speakers include Sandra Coney, writer, health activist and Deputy – Chair of Parks in the Auckland Regional Council; Alan Hall, Associate Professor in the School of Education at the University of Waikato; and Brian Turner, a freelance journalist, editor and writer and Professor Boyd Swinburn, Physical Activity and Nutrition Research Unit, Deakin University, Australia.
