## 3. PARTNERSHIP QUEENSTOWN CONFERENCE – SALE OF LIQUOR ACT

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The purpose of this report is to seek the Council's approval for two elected members to attend the Partnerships Conference in Queenstown.

## **BACKGROUND**

For the last eight years the Alcohol Advisory Council of New Zealand (ALAC) has organised a national conference for agencies working with the Sale of Liquor Act.
