



4. HALSWELL UNITED SOCCER CLUB TRAINING LIGHTS

The Parks and Waterways Area Advocate (Rod Whearty) reported on the application from the Halswell United Soccer Club to the installation of five new poles containing training lights on Halswell Domain.

The Parks and Waterways Manager was given delegated authority from Council (23 October 1996) to approve such applications, subject to the necessary resource consents and consultation with the appropriate Community Board.

The club was formed in 1964 and is based at the domain. Its facilities are also used by cricket and touch sevens rugby clubs. The club is one of the largest in Christchurch, having three senior fields, with a further two senior, two intermediate and three junior fields from this season as a result of the recent extension to the domain.

In **receiving** the report, the Board was happy to support the application, subject to the conditions listed by the Parks and Waterways Manager, but sought an extension to the night time operating curfew, from 8.30 pm to 9.30 pm.
