The purpose of this report is to start the legal procedures necessary to stop the unnamed unformed legal road adjoining Bexley Road.

BACKGROUND

RESOLUTION

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 116 and 117 of the Public Works Act 1981, the Christchurch City Council hereby resolves to stop the portion of road as shown on the plan and described in the Schedule hereto.

REASON FOR ROAD STOPPING

The Council wishes to implement the designation as shown in the notified City Plan and to hold the land for the purpose for which it is being used.

PURPOSE TO WHICH THE STOPPED ROAD WILL BE PUT

The portion of road when stopped will become a recreation area.
