

13. REPORT OF THE WORKS AND TRAFFIC COMMITTEE – 23 JULY 2002

The Board considered a report of a meeting of its Works and Traffic Committee on 23 July 2002.

13.1 33 Woolston Bus Service – Possible Removal of Brookhaven Service

The Board considered the possible removal of the Brookhaven leg of the 33 Woolston bus service.

The Board **resolved**:

1. That owing to the lack of patronage, the Board support the removal of the existing 33 Woolston bus service from the Brookhaven area.
2. That ECAN be requested to consider improving the 33 Woolston bus service to provide weekend and nightly services to the Bromley area.
3. That the City Streets Unit be asked to report on implementing a “safe refuge” on Ferry Road at Charlesworth Street.
4. That the City Streets Unit be asked to report on the possibility of providing pedestrian access to a bus stop on Linwood Avenue near the intersection with Dyers Road.
5. That the City Streets Unit be asked to consider rationalising appropriate bus stops in the Brookhaven area in light of the proposed changes to the 33 Woolston bus service and report back to the Board in October.

13.2 Application for Car Park on Scarborough Road

The Board considered an application from Mr John Bishop, resident of 101 Scarborough Road for a car park on Scarborough Road.

It was moved that the Board endorse the Council’s policy on parking on Scarborough Road and decline Mr Bishop’s application.

The motion was declared carried on a division by five votes to one, the voting being:
