

13. SKIPTON STREET TREES

The Board received a report regarding the trees in Skipton Street as a follow up from a deputation received from a resident.

The Board **resolved**:

1. To decline the Skipton Street residents' request for the street trees to be 'topped' and that current approved maintenance practices continue.
2. That staff investigate the trees being designated as notable trees in the City Plan.
3. That further information be obtained on the impact the trees make to dampness and shading of properties, any issues with street lighting and tree root damage to footpaths.
4. That residents of Skipton Street be included in any discussions regarding the street.
