**1. RELOCATION OF FITZGERALD STATUE TO LATIMER SQUARE**

The purpose of this report is to present some supplementary information regarding the recommendation contained in clause 1 of the report of the joint meeting of the Arts, Culture and Heritage Committee, Parks, Gardens and Waterways and Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee's and the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board held on 9 December 2002.

The joint meeting has recommended that the Fitzgerald statue remain in its present location in Rolleston Avenue.

The following supplementary information has since been obtained, and is now attached to this report:

1. Letter from New Zealand Historic Places Trust expressing the Trust's support for the Fitzgerald statue to be relocated in Latimer Square.
2. Further letter from New Zealand Historic Places Trust, endorsing a quotation submitted by City Salvage Contractors for the relocation of the statue, and offering the Trust's assistance in supervising the relocation work.
3. Quotation of \$5,000 plus GST from City Salvage Contractors for the relocation of the statue and plinth.
