## 10. ARTWORKS IN PUBLIC PLACES POLICY

A report from the Team Leader, Leisure Planning, informed the Board of the findings of the review of the Art in Public Places Policy and recommended the adoption of a new Artworks in Public Places Policy to the Arts, Culture and Heritage Committee. The Board **decided**:

- 1. That the Burwood/Pegasus Community Board recommend to the Arts, Culture and Heritage Committee that the Artworks in Public Places Policy be adopted.
- 2. That the Policy be supported for a change to a proactive emphasis on including the empowering, enabling and facilitating of community initiatives.
- 3. That an appropriate developmental and coordinating role for Community Boards be included in addition to site investigation.
- 4. That regular forums and consultations with working artists and arts administrators be held.
- 5. That the Board convene a Working Party of Glenda Burt, Carmen Hammond, Don Rowlands and Chrissie Williams to promote art in Burwood/Pegasus and to feed into the citywide strategy for artworks in public places.
- 6. That Officers be asked to report on local arts initiatives including the Linwood Gallery, the Dallington Cottage exhibition, the South New Brighton sculpture park, and Marae based art and carving.
- 7. That the Board's Working Party investigate the potential for artistic attractions and galleries at New Brighton.
