

## 5. BUSINESS UNIT RESPONSES TO BOARD'S PLANNING STATEMENT 2002/03

A report from the Community Advocate informed the Board of the responses of Council Business Units to the Board's Key Issues Planning Statement for 2002/03. The Board **decided**:

1. That the information be received.
2. That the Board urge the Council to give priority to cost effective traffic calming and safety measures ahead of Living Streets expenditure.
3. That the Board consider ways to increase bus use in Burwood/Pegasus.
4. That the City Water and Waste Unit be requested to:
  - (a) Add the Ascot/Freeville Residents' Group to the community groups listed in the Burwood Landfill Community Engagement Plan.
  - (b) Organise community site visits to the landfill at six-monthly intervals rather than four-monthly.
  - (c) Add the South New Brighton Residents' Association and the Southshore Ratepayers' Association to the community groups listed in the Christchurch Wastewater Treatment Plant Community Engagement Plan.
5. That the City Streets Unit be requested to:
  - (a) Ensure street sweeping is regularly undertaken to prevent the accumulation of rubbish and associated problems such as flooding.
  - (b) Ask Onyx to ensure that its refuse collectors do not leave non-recyclable bottles in gutters.
6. That the Property Unit be requested to:
  - (a) Report on the outcome of the contamination testing of the Owles Terrace site.
  - (b) Give priority to the completion of lease agreements, in particular for Burwood Playcentre.
  - (c) Complete asset management plans for all Council-owned facilities in the Burwood/Pegasus area.
