9. UPDATE ON COMMUNITY BOARD PROJECT PROPOSALS 2002/03

The Community Secretary informed the Board of the response of Council Business Units to the Board's prioritisation of Project Proposals to the Christchurch City Council Plan: 2003 Edition. The Board **decided:**

1. That the Community Board Chairperson and Community Advocate meet with Unit Managers to promote the following specific project proposals identified by the Board as deserving of a higher priority:

City Streets

- Horseshoe Lake Road (Broomfield Terrace to Lake Terrace Road) Sealing of road shoulder.
- Mairehau Road (Burwood Road to Marshland Road) Pathway/cycleway.
- Horseshoe Lake Road Provision of cycleway for safety of cyclists.
- Frosts Road Walkway (not necessarily sealed).
- QEII Entrance New street entrance.
- Marine Parade (Rawhiti to Lonsdale) New kerb and channel or other edge treatment.
- Bower Avenue Undergrounding.
- Pages/Seaview/New Brighton/Hawke/Owles Roundabout Increase visibility for traffic exiting Owles Terrace and enhance planting/redesign to make more attractive.

Parks and Waterways

- Broomfield Terrace Car parking for access to Burwood Park and Horseshoe Lake Reserve (to check provision for car parking in Horseshoe Lake Reserve Plan).
- 2. That the Board seek an urgent meeting of a joint Board/Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee working party to consider changes to Travis Road and that the recommendations of this working party be included in the Annual Plan process.
- 3. That the Board confirm Saltaire Street as its priority for Living Streets expenditure in the area.
- 4. That, pending an artificial reef feasibility study, a joint meeting be held with the Parks, Gardens and Waterways Committee in mid-late March 2002 with the possibility of an item being included in the Council's proposed budget for 2002/03.
- 5. That Board members and the Parks and Waterways Area Advocate compile an overall priority list for the installation of drinking fountains across Burwood/Pegasus.
