

12. RECOMMENDATIONS FOR ADDITIONAL SOCIAL INITIATIVES PROGRAMME FUNDS

A report was received on recommendations for additional social initiatives programme funds. A discussion was held on the numbers of funding sources available to various groups.

It was **resolved** that officers report to the Community and Leisure Committee on a six monthly basis on social initiatives funded projects.

Addington Maori Community Development Organisation (Spreydon/Heathcote)

The Committee **resolved** that the application from the Addington Maori Community Trust be referred to the 2002/03 social initiatives allocation process for consideration to give the Trust time to establish a base and develop its services.

Asian Youth Trust (Metropolitan)

The Committee **resolved** that the Asian Youth Trust application and this assessment be referred for favourable consideration for a major grant by the Metropolitan Funding Subcommittee.

Canterbury Fiji Social Services Trust (Metropolitan)

The Committee **resolved** that the Canterbury Fiji Social Services Trust be allocated \$20,000 for three years from the Social Initiatives Fund.

Christchurch City Mission (Metropolitan)

Councillor Barry Corbett declared an interest and withdrew from discussions and voting on this item.

The Committee **resolved** that the Christchurch City Mission be granted \$10,000 from the Metropolitan Discretionary Fund and that the application for the Crisis Intervention Social Worker be considered in the 2002/03 social initiatives allocation process (should this still be necessary).

Depression Support Network (Canterbury Support Trust Inc)

The Committee **resolved** that the Depression Support Network be granted \$20,000 for three years from the Social Initiatives Fund.

Drug-Arm Christchurch (Metropolitan)

The Committee **resolved** that the application from Drug-Arm be declined.

Eldercare Canterbury - Fall Prevention (Metropolitan)

The Committee **resolved** that the Metropolitan Discretionary Fund provide \$20,000 to Eldercare Canterbury for this year and that a further \$20,000 be provided for each of the 2002/03 and 2003/04 financial years from the Social Initiatives Programme Fund.

Hei Hei Broomfield Community Development Project (Family and Community Division of Anglican Care Christchurch) (Hei Hei Broomfield)

The Committee **resolved** that Anglican Care be allocated \$30,000 for the two Community Development Worker salaries of the Hei Hei Broomfield Community Development Project for three years from the Social Initiatives Fund.

Home and Family Society (Metropolitan)

The Committee **resolved** that Home and Family application be referred to the 2002/03 social initiatives funding allocation process.

Home Made Partnership Trust (Aranui-Pegasus)

The Committee **resolved** that the Home Made Partnership Trust be allocated \$30,000 for three years from the Social Initiatives Fund.

Linwood Youth 'Trust' (Linwood, Woolston, Bromley, Phillipstown, Aranui, Shirley)

The Committee **resolved** that the Linwood Youth Trust application be referred to the 2002/03 social initiatives funding allocation process.

Maori Legal Services (Metropolitan)

The Committee **resolved** that Maori Legal Services be granted \$20,000 from the Metropolitan Discretionary Fund.

Molten Media Community Trust (Metropolitan)

The Committee **resolved** that the Molten Media application of \$25,000 be referred to the 2002/03 social initiatives funding allocation process.

Te Whatumanawa Maoritanga O Rehua (Metropolitan)

The Committee **resolved** that Te Whatumanawa Maoritanga O Rehua be allocated \$25,000 for the next three years from the Social Initiatives Fund.

Restorative Justice Service (Metropolitan)

The Committee **resolved** that the Restorative Justice Service application and this assessment be referred for consideration for a major grant by the Metropolitan Funding Committee.

Shirley Community Trust (Shirley)

The Committee **resolved** that the Shirley Community Trust be granted \$20,000 for three years from the Social Initiatives Fund subject to a favourable evaluation at the end of each year.

Step Ahead Trust (Metropolitan)

The Committee **resolved** that Step Ahead be granted \$18,800 for three years from the Social Initiative Fund commencing in 2002/03.

Te Ora Hou (Papanui and Metropolitan)

The Committee **resolved** that Te Ora Hou be granted \$15,000 for three years from the Social Initiatives Fund subject to a favourable evaluation at the end of each year.

Te Ropu Tamarihi - Girl Guides Association NZ Canterbury North Region (Metropolitan)

The Committee **resolved** that the application from Te Ropu Tamariki be declined.

Te Whare O Nga Whetu Trust (Hornby-Wigram)

The Committee **resolved** that Te Whare O Nga Whetu be granted \$30,000 for three years from the Social Initiatives Fund commencing in the 2002/03 year.

Youthline Central South Island (Metropolitan)

The Committee **resolved** that the Youthline application and this assessment be referred for consideration for a major grant by the Metropolitan Funding Subcommittee.
