4. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

4.1 Woolston Development Project

Bev Adams from the Woolston Development Project addressed the Board, thanked the Board for the funding support received and reported on the Family Support Worker Role and the Group of After School Programmes (GASP Network).

The funding the Board provided for the family support worker enabled Woodson Development Project to establish a family support worker position. The aims of the position are to maximise family relationships and promote their well being, support individuals within families, and advocate for families. The worker has had contact with 40 families in the past six months. The future of this role is dependent on further funding. Woolston Development Project is now working with families in a management role of Bromley and Linwood After School Programmes and will be able to extend family support to these parents as well.
