



## 6. PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC SIGNALS – BUCKLEYS ROAD AT EASTGATE MALL

A report from the Safety Auditor, City Streets, sought a review of the approval given by the Council for the installation of pedestrian traffic signals in Buckleys Road adjacent to Eastgate Mall.

The Board also considered a report from the meeting of its Works and Traffic Committee.

The Board **decided** to recommend to the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee:

1. That the Board support a decision not to proceed with the installation of pedestrian traffic signals on Buckleys Road adjacent to Eastgate Mall.
2. That consideration be given to spending the funds in the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board area.
3. That the needs of pedestrians in this area continue to be monitored and reported on to the Board at the first meeting of the Board in 2003.
