## 6. PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC SIGNALS – BUCKLEYS ROAD AT EASTGATE MALL

A report from the Safety Auditor, City Streets, sought a review of the approval given by the Council for the installation of pedestrian traffic signals in Buckleys Road adjacent to Eastgate Mall.

The Board also considered a report from the meeting of its Works and Traffic Committee.

The Board **decided** to recommend to the Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee:

- 1. That the Board support a decision not to proceed with the installation of pedestrian traffic signals on Buckleys Road adjacent to Eastgate Mall.
- 2. That consideration be given to spending the funds in the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board area.
- 3. That the needs of pedestrians in this area continue to be monitored and reported on to the Board at the first meeting of the Board in 2003.
