

## 12. APPOINTMENT OF COMMUNITY BOARD REPRESENTATIVES ON OUTSIDE BODIES/AD HOC COMMITTEES

- Liquor Licensing: to provide community input into District Licensing Agency hearings; to be handled through the Board's Environment Committee
  - Reserves Hearing: to hear submissions from the community on Reserve Management Plans; all Board members be members of the hearing panel, with a quorum of three.

In respect of the Community Funding Committee and Riccarton Bush Trust, the following information was noted:

- Community Funding: to consider applications from community groups for grant monies, and to allocate funds received through the Hillary Commission and the Council. Approved by the Board, 21 November 2001.
- Riccarton Bush Trust: to represent the Board on the Trust. Christchurch City Council appointments, being Mr D Buist and Councillor I Ganda are to 9 December 2003 (in accordance with the Riccarton Bush Trust Act). The three Board representatives are Mrs A Wilkie, Mrs H Broughton, and Mr M Mora, whose terms of office expire on 15 December 2003.

The Board also **decided** to appoint a member as a trustee of the Church of the Holy Family Trust (who administer the chapel in Kirk Road, formerly the Templeton Hospital chapel). The Trust Deed makes provision for a trustee to be appointed by the Riccarton/Wigram Community Board.
