2. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

(a) Martin Meehan, Cranford Street Action Group

Martin Meehan presented a written report on behalf of the Cranford Street Action Group, regarding their opposition to the four-laning of Cranford Street proposed in the Northern Roading Option Scoping Study. Their opposition relates to the reduction in property values, the loss of parking, the safety issue of turning into properties on Cranford Street and the issue that Cranford Street residents are bearing the costs of the urban growth to the north of the city and Waimakariri. They suggested that Marshland Road should be reinvestigated, and greater consideration be given to public transport options. Martin also requested \$250 in funding for the hiring of halls, flyer production and distribution, and other associated costs, to allow consultation with the community.

The Board **resolved** to allocate \$250 from 2001/2002 Discretionary Funds to the Cranford Street Action Group.
