



10. OUT OF SCHOOL PROGRAMME DRAFT STRATEGY AND AREA IMPLEMENTATION PLANS

The Out of School Care Programme Project Co-ordinator spoke to her report on the draft Out of School Programme Strategy, also local Area Improvement Plans to assist Board members and staff with priority needs for after school and holiday programmes in their respective areas.

The Board **decided**:

1. That the draft Out of School Programme Strategy be received.
2. That the Board consider area implementation recommendations when allocating and prioritising project funds (2002/05) for local Out of School Programmes (after school and holiday).
3. That the Board consider a three year funding commitment when allocating project funds for Out of School Programmes.
