6. BI-MONTHLY REPORT FROM FESTIVALS AND EVENTS SUB COMMITTEE

A report from the Leisure Manager detailed the work currently being carried out by the Festivals and Events Subcommittee including recommendations on funding of in-house and core funded festivals for 2002/03.

The Committee received the report, and **resolved**:

- 1. That Young Inventionz be granted funding of \$10,000 in 2002/3 from the New Festivals Fund, subject to confirmation of the overall festivals and events funding in the 2002/3 Annual Plan.
- 2. That the application for funding from the New Festivals Fund for the Eat, Move, Live festival be declined, and that staff work with the festival organisers to identify how its aims might be advanced through the Push Play with Active Christchurch programme and the Healthy Christchurch project.
- 3. That funding for the Garden Festival be \$180,000 for 2002/3 (subject to finalisation of the Annual Plan) with an intended initial festival in 2004.

(**Note:** Councillor Sally Buck declared an interest in and retired from the discussion and voting on the Young Inventionz Funding request).
