5. AVON-HEATHCOTE ESTUARY IHUTAI TRUST

A report from the Parks and Waterways Planner updated Board members on recent developments relating to the possible formation of an Avon-Heathcote Estuary Trust, Council involvement in the proposed Trust and the writing of a non-statutory management plan for the Estuary. The Board **decided** to recommend to the Parks, Gardens and Waterways Committee:

- 1. That the Christchurch City Council support the formation of an Avon-Heathcote Estuary Ihutai Trust and be willing to work and interact with this trust and Environment Canterbury to develop a non-statutory plan for the Avon-Heathcote Estuary/Ihutai.
- 2. That this report be referred to the joint Christchurch City Council/Environment Canterbury Coastal and Estuary Working Party for consideration.
- 3. That when the Trust is formed the Council draw up a Memorandum of Understanding with the Trust that also clarifies the statutory powers and governance responsibilities of each Council and its relationship to the Trust.
- 4. That consideration be given to the role of the Travis Wetland Trust as an operational model for the Estuary Ihutai Trust.
