8. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

8.1 Dog Duty Station – Stephen Visser

Stephen Visser addressed the Board regarding the introduction of dog duty stations at city locations dispensing free bio-degradable paper bags and scoops to dog owners. The purpose of his address was to inform the Board about the dog duty stations project and elicit the Board's support for expansion of the project.

In his submissions, Mr Visser stated that the Council's Parks and Waterways Unit was currently trialling the dog duty stations for three months in three Christchurch locations.

The Board **decided** to wait until this trial was completed before considering whether to support the project.
