16. SALISBURY STREET (CAMBRIDGE GREEN) – PARKING RESTRICTIONS

A report from the Area Engineer sought the Board's approval to install parking restrictions in Salisbury Street, Cambridge Terrace and Barbadoes Street, as part of work being undertaken at Cambridge Green.

The Board **resolved**:

- 1. That the parking of vehicles be prohibited on the northern side of Salisbury Street from its intersection with Barbadoes Street in a easterly direction for a distance of 36 metres to its intersection with Cambridge Terrace.
- 2. That the parking of vehicles be prohibited on the southern side of Salisbury Street from its intersection with Barbadoes Street in a easterly direction for a distance of 50 metres to its intersection with Cambridge Terrace.
- 3. That the parking of vehicles be prohibited on the western side of Cambridge Terrace from its intersection with Salisbury Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 30 metres.
- 4. That the parking of vehicles be prohibited on the eastern side of Cambridge Terrace from its intersection with Salisbury Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 30 metres.
- 5. That the parking of vehicles be prohibited on the eastern side of Barbadoes Street from its intersection with Salisbury Street in a southerly direction for a distance of 100 metres to its intersection with Oxford Terrace.
- 6. That the parking of vehicles be prohibited on the northern side of Salisbury street from its intersection with Barbadoes Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 30 metres.
