



2. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

Mrs Frances Ryman addressed the Committee and provided a written submission on the historical and horticultural significance of the Kilmore Street, Avonside Drive, Fitzgerald Avenue and Oxford Terrace intersection, and the associated issues regarding public open space in this area.

Mrs Ryman outlined the valuable (but yet to be acknowledged) contribution to the historical development of this area by William Guise Brittan.

The Committee **decided**:

1. That the possible creation of a conservation zone acknowledging the historical and horticultural significance of this junction be referred to the Urban Planning and Growth Special Committee for consideration.
2. That the Parks Unit in consultation with Mrs Ryman prepare a schedule of appropriate horticultural improvements to the junction.
