

## 15. CRANFORD STREET/INNES ROAD INTERSECTION: PROPOSED PARKING RESTRICTIONS

The Board received a report regarding the installation of parking restrictions in the vicinity of the shops at the intersection of Cranford Street and Innes Road. The Area Engineer advised that a parking survey was distributed to the local residents and the shop owners were spoken to individually.

The Board **resolved:**

1. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited at any time in Cranford Street on the south west side commencing at the bus stop two metres south of the southern boundary of No. 253 and proceeding in a north westerly direction for a distance of 23 metres.
2. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of sixty minutes between the hours of 8.30 am to 5.00 pm Monday to Friday on the northeast side of Cranford Street commencing at a point six metres from its intersection with Knowles Street and extending in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 43.5 metres.
3. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of sixty minutes between the hours of 8.30 am to 5.00 pm Monday to Friday on the southwest side of Cranford Street commencing at a point 33.5 metres from its intersection with Knowles Street and extending in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 24.5 metres.
4. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to a maximum period of sixty minutes between the hours of 8.30 am to 5.00 pm Monday to Friday on the northwest side of Innes Road commencing at a point six metres from its intersection with Cranford Street and extending in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 60.5 metres.
