

18. TRANSPORT COMMITTEE

The Board **resolved** that the report of the meeting of the Transport Committee of 12 June 2002 be received and its recommendations adopted as follows:

18.1 Huntsbury Avenue – Traffic Safety Concerns

1. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited (at any time) on the east side of Huntsbury Avenue commencing at a point 180 metres from its intersection with Aotea Terrace and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 78 metres.
2. That the stopping of vehicles be prohibited (at any time) on the west side of Huntsbury Avenue commencing at a point 170 metres from its intersection with Aotea Terrace and extending in a southerly direction for a distance of 10 metres.
3. That staff be asked to investigate traffic management measures to investigate methods of reducing traffic speeds on Huntsbury Avenue, for example, signage, marking a centre line, etc.
4. That residents living adjacent to the proposed no stopping lines be advised of the Board's decision.

18.2 Southey/Longfellow Project

That a letter be sent to all residents in Southey and Longfellow Streets in conjunction with the Start Work Notice advising them of the Council's intention to remove the three speed humps, and setting out the reasons for their removal.

18.3 Colombo Street Cycle Improvements

That the proposal to provide adequate cycling facilities on Colombo Street between Carlyle and Hutcheson Streets, as reported, be progressed to public consultation.

18.4 Strickland Street – Milton Road to Somerfield Street – Cycle Facility Provision

That a proposal to provide cycle facilities on Strickland Street from Milton Street to Somerfield Street be presented to a future meeting of the Community Board for progressing to public consultation.
