



## 9. **COMMUNITY ADVOCATE'S UPDATE**

### **SPITTING IN PUBLIC**

1. That the Board write to public health authorities expressing concern at the level of spitting on footpaths and requesting an education campaign to alleviate this problem.

### **DRAFT PUBLIC STREET ENCLOSURES POLICY**

2. (a) That the Board recommend that New Brighton be considered as a special area within the draft Public Street Enclosures Policy because of its climatic conditions.  
  
(b) That a Subcommittee be convened of Bob Andrews, Glenda Burt, Caroline Kellaway and Don Rowlands with delegated authority to make a submission on the draft Policy.

### **WORKSHOP ON STV VOTING**

3. That the Board request the Christchurch City Council to hold a seminar on STV voting for elected members.

### **CREATIVE PLACES AWARD 2002**

4. That the Board submit an application for a Creative Places Award 2002 for the Horseshoe Lake shelter.
