

4. REFUSE (TRANSFER) STATION UPGRADES

Members considered a report from Mike Stockwell, City Water and Waste Manager, seeking confirmation on the funding arrangements for the modifications required to refuse transfer stations necessary to match them to the Kate Valley refuse transfer transport system.

The report noted that all three Christchurch City Council refuse transfer stations would require modification and the Banks Peninsula District Council Barry's Bay Transfer Station would in addition also require some modification.

The opportunity was taken to discuss the report and it was indicated that merit was seen in councils retaining control of their transfer stations and that in respect to the Christchurch City Council refuse transfer stations the costs involved were at present fully funded by the existing gate charges.

It was noted that for the Waimakariri District Council and Selwyn District Council there would be some variation in the transport arrangements required and different dedicated trucks would in actual fact be required for these two councils.

The Subcommittee **resolved** that territorial local authorities fund their own refuse station modifications.
