The purpose of this report is to recommend to the Council that it start the legal procedures necessary to stop a portion of legal road.

The reason for this road stopping is to stop a portion of Barton Street/Bamford Street for traffic management purposes.

The road stopping action is to coincide with the new Jubilee Street extension link road. On 3 April the Board considered a report on the Jubilee Street Extension and recommended that it approve in accordance with the provisions of Sections 319 and 342 of the Local Government Act 1974, the commencement of the formal procedure to stop a diagonal strip of land between 69 and 72 Bamford Street.

The City Streets Unit agrees with this proposal. The proposed road stopping is not shown in the Notified City Plan.

## RESOLUTION

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 319(h) and 342 of the Local Government Act 1974, the Christchurch City Council hereby resolves to stop that portion of road as shown on the plan and described in the schedule hereto.

## REASON FOR THE ROAD STOPPING

The reason for this road stopping is to legally restrict vehicle access onto Bamford Street from Barton Street. The physical stopping of the street will be carried out at the time of the construction of the Jubilee Street extension.

## PURPOSE TO WHICH THE STOPPED ROAD WILL BE PUT

The portion of road when stopped will be held by the Council in fee simple and used for landscaping purposes pursuant to Section 345(b) of the Local Government Act 1974.
