



3. CHRISTCHURCH – LITTLE RIVER CYCLEWAY PRESENTATION

Craig Mason (Environment Canterbury) and Victoria Lawson (Council Cycle Planner) gave a presentation on this project, which is being co-ordinated by a multi-disciplined working party (made up of local authorities, government agencies, community groups, etc).

Environment Canterbury and the Department of Conservation had been promoting a cycleway/walkway between Motukarara and Little River, which was to run along the old railway embankment.

The Transport Studies Group (Lincoln University) were similarly promoting a cycleway between Prebbleton and Lincoln.

The City Council is continually planning cycleways; it seemed logical to link these initiatives to make a continuous route from Christchurch to Little River.

Members saw great benefits in the project, and are keen to continue the Board's involvement with the working party.
