



10. COMMUNITY FUNDING

The Board received a report of the Community Funding Committee Meeting held on 9 May 2002.

The Board **decided** to recommend to the Leisure Unit:

1. That the Council ask the Hillary Commission to reconsider its policy on funding safety equipment. This equipment is part of playing sport and taking part in physical activity.
2. That the Council ask the Hillary Commission to reconsider its funding priorities so that sport and activity at grass roots level is able to access funding. This is not occurring with the current priorities.
3. That the Council ask Sport Canterbury to promote Hillary Commission Funding through the regional sports organisations.
