



## 7. LIZ McCLURE 116 CRANFORD STREET

Councillor Stonhill tabled a copy of correspondence from Ms McClure relating to parking in the central city area. Ms McClure indicated that she currently parked in the four avenues area, as she worked in the central city, but was unable to utilise public transport in view of the fact that she commenced work at 6.15am and the relevant bus service did not commence until 6.40am.

It was decided that the correspondence from Ms McClure also be referred to the Joint Special Working Party and in addition the Chairman took the opportunity to seek comments from members on the provision of unmarked parking for Councillors and the possibility the number of car parks be reduced from 27 to 20 parks only, on an unnamed basis, with utilisation on a 'first come first served basis'.

After discussion it was **agreed** that:

1. Staff be asked to undertake a survey of the Councillors car park to ascertain the extent of usage and to what degree this area is utilised by other than elected representatives, and what would be the implications of reducing the amount of parking as above.
2. That the matter be reported in due course to an unpaid subcommittee consisting of the Chairman and Councillors Chrissie Williams, Ingrid Stonhill and Ron Wright.
