

## 15. ST ASAPH STREET – PARKING RESTRICTION

The Committee considered a report seeking approval to the installation of a loading zone in St Asaph Street between High Street and Manchester Street.

The provision of a loading zone related to the need to provide for delivery of goods to the McKenzie and Willis Trading Store and the problems caused by vehicles stopping in the traffic lane and disrupting through-traffic.

The Committee **resolved**:

1. That the P60 parking restriction on the north side of St Asaph Street commencing at a point 32 metres from its intersection with Manchester Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 94 metres be revoked.
2. That the parking of vehicles be restricted to 60 minutes on the north side of St Asaph Street commencing at a point 32 metres from its intersection with Manchester Street and extending in an easterly direction for a distance of 80 metres.
3. That a loading zone with a time limit of 5 minutes be created on the north side of St Asaph Street commencing at a point 112 metres from its intersection with Manchester Street and extending in an easterly direction for 14 metres.
