## 4. METROPOLITAN COMMUNITY DISCRETIONARY FUNDING

The Committee received a report from the Community Relations Funding Adviser on grants made from the Metropolitan Community Discretionary Fund. The fund is administered by the Community Relations Unit. Of the \$153,779 available for the 2001/02 financial year, \$132,000 was allocated as follows:
