14. MEMORIAL AVENUE – PROPOSED RATIONALISATION OF BUS STOPS

The Area Engineer sought the approval of the Board to rationalise various bus stops in Memorial Avenue between Burnside Park and the Commodore Motor Inn.

The report noted that the resident at 320 Memorial Avenue had specifically requested that the existing bus stop outside her property be removed. Any change was opposed by Environment Canterbury and no other suitable location was available in the immediate area.

Having considered the report, the Board **resolved**:

- 1. That the bus stop at No. 320 Memorial Avenue remain in its present position.
- 2. That the following bus stops be removed:
 - On the south west side of Memorial Avenue commencing at a point 32 metres north west of its intersection with Roydvale Avenue and extending in a northwesterly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
 - On the south west side of Memorial Avenue commencing at a point 230 metres north west of its intersection with Roydvale Avenue and extending in a northwesterly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
 - On the south west side of Memorial Avenue commencing at a point 406 metres north west of its intersection with Roydvale Avenue and extending in a northwesterly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
- 3. That the following bus stops be installed:
 - On the south west side of Memorial Avenue commencing at a point 66 metres south east of its intersection with Roydvale Avenue and extending in a southeasterly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
 - On the south west side of Memorial Avenue commencing at a point 188 metres north west of its intersection with Roydvale Avenue and extending in a northwesterly direction for a distance of 12 metres.
 - On the south west side of Memorial Avenue commencing at a point 422.5 metres north west
 of its intersection with Roydvale Avenue and extending in a northwesterly direction for a
 distance of 12 metres.
