

3. WORKS TRAFFIC AND ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE - REPORT OF 12 FEBRUARY 2002

The Board considered the meeting report and accompanying recommendations and **decided** as follows:

3.1 Deputations by Appointment

Telstra Clear – Update

Information was **received** on the current status of the city wide programme including a recent decision made by the company to place on hold the roll out of its Christchurch network.

Fendalton Park – Redevelopment Plan

1. That priority be given to refurbishing/renewing the existing playground equipment and further that the Board seek to have the funding for the public toilet re-allocated to improve the existing car park off Fendalton Road.
2. That the outcome on these matters be conveyed back to the local community and the Board in due course.

Staff noted a Board request that a sign be installed indicating the availability of toilet facilities within the park.

3.2 Introduction to the Safe Cycling to School Project

That the information be received.

3.3 Maintenance Issues

The Board confirmed the holding of two separate seminars, one being a joint session with the Shirley/Papanui Community Board on contract maintenance arrangements for City Streets and Parks and Waterways; the other being a Board seminar on the Council's enforcement responsibilities with emphasis on the activities undertaken by the Environmental Services Unit.

3.4 General Issues

A report is to be submitted to the Committee on the process and timeframes associated with Board reviews on the Bishopdale Shopping Centre, Jellie Park Aqualand, Ring Road, and Memorial Avenue landscaping enhancement.
