

12. CORRESPONDENCE

12.1 60 Minute Parking Restrictions in Fitzgerald Avenue

A letter was received from D Alexander and a number of businesses in Fitzgerald Avenue between Ferry Road and Moorhouse Avenue requesting that 60 minute parking restrictions be imposed outside their premises.

The Board was told that this issue was under investigation in another area with a report due to come to the next meeting of the Board. The Board **resolved** to defer further consideration of this letter until the next ordinary meeting and to advise the correspondents of that.

12.2 Canterbury Branch of Blind Citizens of New Zealand Inc

A letter was received from the Canterbury Branch Secretary of the Blind Citizens of New Zealand Inc about the Buckleys Road pedestrian crossing.

The Board **resolved** to ask Brian Neill to write to the Canterbury Branch of Blind Citizens, to inform them of the reasons for not proceeding with the project at this stage, to further discuss the issues with them and advise that the area will be monitored and reported to the Board in November 2002.

12.3 Cypress Street

A letter was received from the Bromley Community Residents Inc about seal widening work which is to commence in Cypress Street.

The Board **resolved** to ask the Area Engineer to monitor usage of the street for a footpath. The issue will be raised in the annual plan process.

12.4 2003 Community Boards Conference

A letter was received from the Chairperson of the 2003 Community Boards Conference Subcommittee, which is being hosted by the New Plymouth District Council inviting the Board to indicate the number of representatives it may send and information on topics for panels and workshops.

The Board **resolved** to advise the organising subcommittee that it will be sending at least one delegate.
