(d) Martin Meehan, Cranford Street Proposed No Stopping Restriction

Martin Meehan spoke to the Board regarding clause 19, the proposed no stopping restriction on Cranford Street. Martin advised that he did not consider Cranford Street a minor arterial road as described in the officer's report. He also advised that the shops at the intersection of Cranford Street and Innes Road would be affected by this no stopping restriction, and that it would make parking even more difficult for customers. He stated that he came to the Board in July 2001 regarding parking around this intersection and suggested some solutions (maps were provided to Board members).

Martin requested that the no stopping restriction be replaced with a 60 minute parking restriction.
