



10. SELWYN DISTRICT COUNCIL CROSS BOUNDARY ISSUES

The Committee gave consideration to a report overviewing the main cross-boundary issues affecting Christchurch City and Selwyn District as follows:

- Summit Road Protection Act
- Boundary Adjustments
- District Plan/City Plan Issues
- Regional Council matters
- Halswell Catchment
- Transport

The Committee **decided** that an informal meeting be held with Selwyn District Council and the Riccarton/Wigram Community Board with a specific agenda that includes at least the following reports prepared in consultation with Selwyn District Council officers:

- (a) A discussion paper outlining options and processes to agree on possible boundary adjustments
- (b) The merits of establishing a joint working group (which will include staff from other local authorities) to examine and recommend options for managing the Halswell River Catchment and Summit Road Protection Area.
- (c) With reference to the comments of the Environment Court mentioned above, the need for a joint approach managing urban growth in Christchurch and surrounding districts.
