

## 6. CORRESPONDENCE

### 6.1 Ferrymead Heritage Report

The Board **resolved** to receive a letter from the Ferrymead Heritage Park who thanked the Board for the consideration of a request for discretionary funding.

### 6.2 Phillipstown School

A letter was received from the Principal of Phillipstown School seeking funding of \$2,090 to preserve Phillipstown School historical material.

The Board **resolved** to grant \$2,090 from its discretionary funding to Phillipstown School for the purpose of preserving historical material for the following three projects: photo albums, a photo gallery and a wall cabinet.

### 6.3 Redcliffs Public Library

The Board **resolved** to receive a letter from Redcliffs Public Library thanking the Board for funding of \$1,100 for the 2002/03 financial year.

### 6.4 Heathcote Valley Community Library

The Board **resolved** to receive a letter from the Heathcote Valley Community Library thanking the Board for funding of \$1,100 for the 2002/03 financial year.
