

11. LAGAN STREET HEALTHY STREET TREE REMOVAL

This report was held over from the April meeting so members could consult with residents. Board members reported that the majority of residents in the street were happy with the trees being replaced with Japanese Maple, however there were several residents, including some elderly people who did not want a tree at all. The Chairperson had the numbers in the street that want replacement trees.

The Board **resolved:**

1. That the existing street trees in Lagan Street be removed with the exception of the Liquid Amber tree outside number 53, and the trees in the landscape area at the Johns Road end of Lagan Street.
2. That replacement trees (Japanese Maple) be planted outside the properties where the owners have indicated they wish to have a tree.
