14. SHIRLEY ROAD KERB AND CHANNEL RENEWAL

The Board received a report on the kerb and channel renewal in Shirley Road from Hills Road to Quinns Road. The Information Manager (City Streets) advised that consultation was continuing on setting back the bus stops. One of the bus stops is to be moved from Emmett Street to Shirley Road. Board members asked whether the bus users had been consulted. The Information Manager advised that this is usually done by the Transportation Planner. It was also queried whether the new bus stop was far enough from the Emmett Street intersection to allow enough visibility for vehicles turning right.

The Chairperson asked whether the plan was prepared before or after the Hammersley site change, and requested that the plan go to the Shirley Community Centre Management Committee and Creche for consultation on angle parking on Slater Street.

Board members also discussed a deputation to the next Sustainable Transport and Utilities Committee meeting. It was decided that Dennis attend if possible, but that as Megan Evans and Ingrid Stonhill were members of that committee they could speak on behalf of the Board.

The Board **resolved** to lay this item on the table pending discussion with the Shirley Community Centre Management Committee.
