



6. DEPUTATIONS BY APPOINTMENT

(b) HAGLEY/FERRYMEAD COMMUNITY BOARD - HAGLEY AVENUE PROPOSED CYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN FACILITIES PROVISION

Mr Yani Johanson and Rod Cameron from the Hagley/Ferrymead Community Board and Councillor Erin Baker attended and spoke regarding the proposed provision of enhanced cycle and pedestrian facilities within Hagley Avenue. Board members expressed concern at the proposal to locate cycleways on the road and wished to see these segregated from motor vehicle traffic and were also concerned at the loss of car parking within this area.

The Board also suggested the provision of diagonal parking adjacent to Hagley Park.

Mr Cameron expressed concern at the proposal to utilise access via Selwyn Street as opposed to having a right-hand turn from Moorhouse Avenue to Hagley Avenue, which he felt would be a safer alternative and he expressed preference for the possible utilisation of the existing pathway within the park for cyclists.

The opportunity was then taken to allow members to ask questions of the deputation and the comments from the deputation were considered in association with clause 5 of the agenda.
