1. CORRESPONDENCE

1.1 NEW BRIGHTON ART GALLERY

A letter was received from the organising committee of the New Brighton Art Gallery acknowledging the Board's support in the establishment of the gallery. The Board **decided** that the letter be received.

1.2 BROCKENHURST STREET - INSTALLATION OF SPEED HUMPS

A letter was received from 19 residents in the Brockenhurst Street area requesting that speed humps be installed in their street. The Board **decided** that a meeting be held with residents in the Brockenhurst Street area to discuss their traffic concerns.

1.3 DALLINGTON COMMUNITY WALKABOUT

A letter was received from Norah Southorn, Dallington Residents' Association, regarding the Dallington community walkabout held on 22 March 2003. The Board **decided:**

- 1. That the Board allocate \$200 from the 2002/03 Community Response Assistance Fund for daffodil bulbs to be planted at a site in Dallington to be approved by the Parks and Waterways Area Advocate.
- 2. That the Board request a report from the Parks and Waterways Unit on:
 - The effects of weed in the Avon River (between Swanns Road and the Estuary) on recreation, the environment, and the health and safety of users;
 - Options for improving weed maintenance within an holistic management plan (including dredging and additional weeding capacity); and
 - The Council's legal liability on health and safety grounds.
- 3. That the Parks and Waterways Unit be asked to consider a plan for a grit walkway from Kerrs Reach to New Brighton Road.
